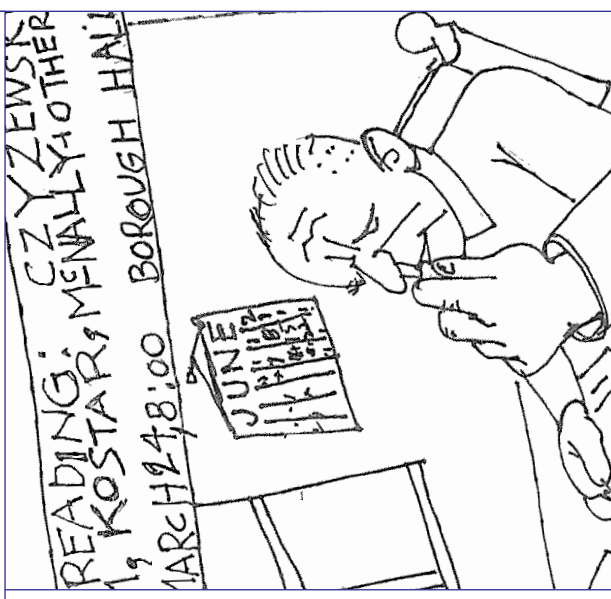
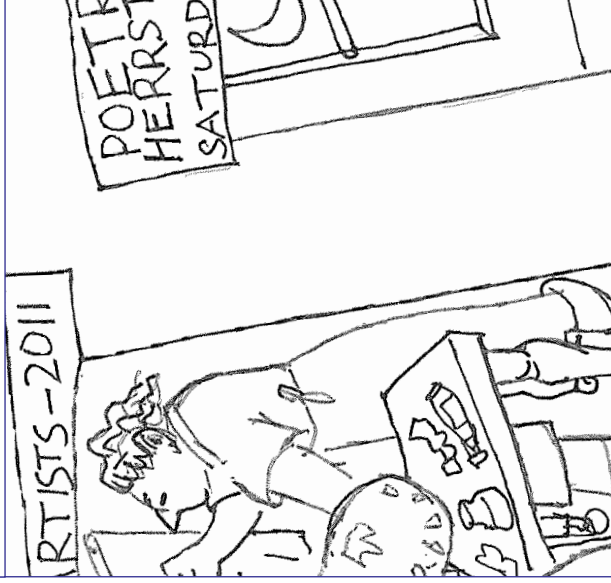

**DIRECTIONS**

Roosevelt is on Rte. 571, about 5 miles east and south of Hightstown. Upon entering town going south on Rte. 571 (Rochdale Ave.), the Borough Hall is the first building on the left. To go to the Assifa Space, continue through town on Rochdale Avenue and make a right onto Tamara Drive. To go to the factory, Oscar Drive is the first left as you enter town.
